


Every minister is encouraged to follow the guidelines outlined below. Staying consistent helps us create a unified presence for our online audience, and it also enhances your local reputation in your community and beyond. Female ministers, please do not take your images in clergy dresses or use any other collar that is not represented below.



1. To the Trial Bishop and all Ordained Elders within the North Carolina Diocese: Please include a headshot image of yourself in clergy attire (plain/ solid black suit with no embellishments or designs), a full black shirt, and not a ministerial dickie with a full white collar, for both men and women. We ask that you only wear the full white collar shown herein. No hats, robes, or tippets are to be worn, and for our female ministers, only small stud earrings are to be worn, and for all ministers of every rank, no additional jewelry (other than a wedding band) should be worn.

Only the Trial Bishop may also include an image wearing a purple clergy shirt with a black suit, which is required with no embellishments or designs.

Each image taken is to have the pose of the above image. Please ensure that there is spacing around the shoulders to ensure your image is not tight and the shoulders are cropped. *Note:* Please have the photographer to take the image a maximum of 6 feet away from you and no less than 4 feet away from you. It is preferred if the image is taken while standing and against a clear wall. Your image should mirror the image above. No exceptions will be permitted at this time.

For Local Ministers & Exhorters within the North Carolina Diocese: Please headshot image of yourself in clergy attire (plain/ solid black suit with no embellishments or designs), a full black shirt, and not a ministerial dickie with a full white collar, for both men and women. We ask that you only wear the tab white collar shown herein. No hats, robes, or tippets are to be worn, and for our female ministers, only small stud earrings are to be worn, and for all ministers of every rank, no additional jewelry (other than a wedding band) should be worn.

Each image taken is to have the pose of the above image. Please ensure that there is spacing around the shoulders to ensure your image is not tight and the shoulders are cropped. *Note:* Please have the photographer to take the image a maximum of 6 feet away from you and no less than 4 feet away from you.
